- **Competency level assessment**
 - What does that mean?
 - How does EPAS 2022 differ from EPAS 2015 or 2008?
- **Evaluation of student practicum as reported assessment measure**



Other Considerations & Concerns

- **Field Instructor ease**
- **Length & time to complete**
- **Program reporting constraints**
- **Utility for professional development**
 - Opportunity to provide narrative feedback
 - Available for reflection
 - Record for student future use

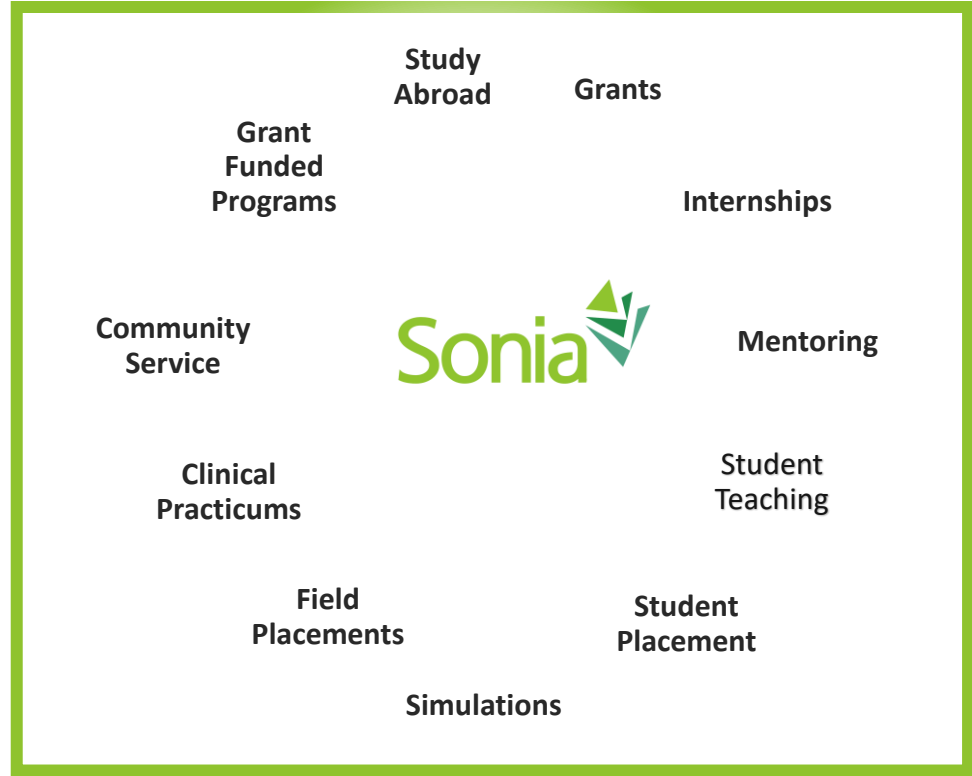
